Subject: 2023-2024 LARGEST TAXPAYERS BILLED

Attached is a list of the top ten owner names and dollars billed for the 2023-2024 secured annual property tax year. The billing amount for these taxpayers totals \$86,474,634.58 or about 3.07 percent of the County's 2023-2024 annual secured tax roll in the amount of \$2,816,733,747.78, and is \$5,322,912.89, or about 6.56 percent more than the previously reported amounts.

The secured property tax roll includes ad valorem tax and direct levies. Ad valorem tax includes one percent general tax and bond debt service. Direct levies include special assessments, bond assessments, special taxes and direct user charges.
